- A. When we knew Naaman from a distance, we would be jealous.
- B. What we see on Naaman under his nice clothes, God sees in us!
 - 1. We are unclean in God's sight
 - 2. We are under God's curse
 - 3. We are helpless and hopeless in this condition

II. The Good News:

- A. The good news bearer: 2-3
- B. The good news acted on: 4
- C. The good news misunderstood: 4-5
 - 1. Naaman went to wrong address
 - 2. Naaman also took millions of dollars
- D. The good news rejected: vs. 8-12
 - 1. Naaman came finally to the write 'preacher' (Matt. 11:28)
 - 2. Yet instead of obeying the instruction, he became angry and went home
- E. The Good News received: 13-14
 - 1. God didn't give up on Naaman and won the battle
 - 2. God wins the battle when we submit to His plan of salvation (vs. 14)
