What is Salvation?

Understanding the Situation – Romans 10:1, 9-17

Intro: This answer to this question begins with two basic facts:

I. We need to understand our situation with God

A. What natural theology teaches us:

1. There is a God – Psalm 19:1; Romans 1:20
2. He is the Creator of all things – Acts 17:24-25
3. He is sovereign – “The King” – Acts 17:25
4. Mankind is accountable to Him – Romans 14:12

B. What natural theology does **NOT** teach us:

1. God’s love for mankind – John 3:16
2. God’s provision for our forgiveness – John 3:16
3. Mankind’s need for spiritual life (“regeneration”) – John 3:3-9
4. God’s plan for our redemption – John 3:16

II. We need to believe the Bible – 2 Timothy 3:15-17

1. The Bible is our source of authority – 2 Timothy 3:16
2. The Bible teaches us what natural theology does not – 2 Timothy 3:15
