JESUS' SERMON ABOUT JESUS

I. How He preached it? II. When He preached it? III. Why He preached it?

I. How Jesus preached this sermon?

- A. Jesus preached this message by His amazing actions in vs. 1-9
 - 1. Jesus saved a man who was a poor slave (vs. 2)
 - 2. While living in his lonely castle Zacchaeus heard about a Jew named Jesus
 - a. what was different about this Jewish teacher?
 - b. what difficulty Zacchaeus met in seeking to see Jesus? (vs. 3)
 - c. how he solved his problems? (vs. 4)
- B. Yet this story is not about Zacchaeus seeking to see Jesus!
 - 1. Jesus came to seek and save a Jewish man lost (vs. 9-10)
- C. What is God saying to us by this?

II. When did He preach it?

- A. He did while sitting in Zachaeus house (vs. 8)
 - 1. How Jesus got there is one of most beautiful sermons about Jesus (v 5-6)
 - a. Jesus saw him
 - b. Jesus spoke to him, using his name
 - c. Jesus commanded him
 - 2. What Jesus did became the 'talk of the town' (vs. 7)
- B. What is Jesus' message to us?
 - 1. Do you think you are too bad or too unimportant for Jesus?
 - 2. He really seeks you personally though He knows you are lost in sin!

III. Why did He preach it?

- A. He preached His sermon to explain what happened to Zachaeus
 - 1. Look what an amazing change took place in this selfish thug (vs. 8)
 - 2. Reason why this happened: vs. 9-10
- B. He preached us to tell us all about His real glory and goodness
 - 1. I am the all-knowing One Who seeks and saves sinners like you
 - a. you are as known to Him as Zacchaeus was
 - b. you are as lost as Zacchaeus was
 - c. In spite of that, He not only welcomes but desires to be with you
 - 2. I am the sinner-loving Savior
 - a. No sinner is a saint before God saves them!
 - b. His capacity to save and love is infinite
 - Zacchaeus couldn't resist it (vs. 8)
 - as Zacchaeus saw the glory of Jesus, he changed
 - 3. I am the sovereign Savior
 - a. There was a 'divine must' in Jesus' command (vs. 5)
 - b. There is Someone Who brought salvation to Zacchaeus (vs. 9)

What will be your response to Jesus today?

- A. Will obey Him and make haste to come to this seeking and saving Savior?
- B. Will you believe that He came to seek and save what is lost?
