The Death of Jesus -

- 1) From God's standpoint - the death was a propitiation where God's holiness & justice were fully satisfied (Rom 3:25-26)
- 2) From Jesus' standpoint it was: a sacrifice offering (Eph 5:2)
- 3) From the Believer's standpoint - Substitutionary - the act of obedience (Phlp 2:8) - just dying for the unjust (1 Pet 3:18)
- 4) From Satan's standpoint - A) Triumph - he bruised his head (Gen 3:15)
B) His defeat (Heb 2:14) - bruise his head.
- 5) From World's Standpoint - unwarranted killing of an innocent man

The law of jurisprudence states that if the testimony of eyewitnesses (sworn to under oath) is not disproved at that time and thereafter it is reduced to written form, it can not be set aside or nullified unless conclusively evidence is produced to overthrow its testimony.
