#### Romans 14

- 1 Him that is weak in the faith receive ye, but not to doubtful disputations.
- 2 For one believeth that he may eat all things: another, who is weak, eateth herbs.
- 3 Let not him that eateth despise him that eateth not; and let not him which eateth not judge him that eateth: for God hath received him.
- 4 Who art thou that judgest another man's servant? to his own master he standeth or falleth. Yea, he shall be holden up: for God is able to make him stand.
- 5 One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day alike. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind.
- 6 He that regardeth the day, regardeth it unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard it. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.
- 7 For none of us liveth to himself, and no man dieth to himself.
- 8 For whether we live, we live unto the Lord; and whether we die, we die unto the Lord: whether we live therefore, or die, we are the Lord's.
- 9 For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived, that he might be Lord both of the dead and living.

### Romans 5:1-9

10.9.10.9.

**1** Justifi'd by faith, as now we have been;

**3** But more than that we rejoice in trials.

**5** This blessed hope now; it will not shame us;

God placed the sinner into Christ's hand.

**7** For one will hardly die for the just man:  
Yet for a good man, he'll perhaps dare.

**8** But God commendeth His great love tow'rd us:  
Christ's death fulfill'd all the law's demands.

**9** Since justified then by Jesus Christ's blood,  
How much more rather, shall we be saved,  
From God's wrath through Christ's laying down His life:  
Perfect, eternal, holy, most grand.
