Romans 12: 9 - 21 May 9, 2010

- God Requires That His Children Live In Genuine Love, Not Be "Bad Actors", (vs. 9 21)
 - Love Unhypocritical Is Always Devoted, (vs. 9 13)
 - "Genuine, (un / hypo / critical)" **ανυποκριτοσ**, originally to be inexperienced in acting, (vs. 9a) "The aim of our charge is love that issues from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith.
 - 6. We must be experienced at rejoicing in what Christ has promised, (vs. 12a)
 - "Therefore my heart is GLAD, and my whole being REJOICES; my flesh also DWELLS secure.
 - For you will not ABANDON my soul to Sheol, or LET your holy one see corruption.
 - o You make KNOWN to me the path of life;
 - o in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore." (Psalm 16:9-11)
 - 7. We must be experienced at enduring patiently when opposition to those promises comes, (vs. 12b)
 - "BE STILL before the Lord and WAIT patiently for him;
 - o fret not yourself over the one who prospers in his way,
 - o over the man who carries out evil devices!
 - o REFRAIN from anger, and FORSAKE wrath! Fret not yourself; it tends only to evil.
 - o For the evildoers shall be CUT off,
 - o but those who wait for the Lord shall INHERIT the land." (Psalm 37:7-9)
 - 8. We must be experienced at remaining constantly in connection with God, (vs. 12c)
 - "In return for my love they accuse me, but I give myself to prayer. So they REWARD me evil for good, and hatred for my love." (Psalm 109:4-5)
 - 9. We must be experienced at providing relief to those who are struggling for Christ's sake, (vs. 13a)
 - "We want you to know, brothers, about the grace of God that has been GIVEN among the churches of Macedonia,
 - o for in a severe test of affliction, their abundance of joy and their extreme poverty have overflowed in a wealth of generosity on their part.
 - For they gave according to their means, as I can testify, and beyond their means, of their own accord,
 - begging us earnestly for the favor of taking part in the relief of the saints"
 (2 Corinthians 8:1-4)
 - 10. We must be experienced at exhibiting openness & acceptance toward those God brings, (vs. 13b)
 - "Show hospitality to one another without grumbling.
 - As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace:
 - whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God;
 - whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies
 - in order that in everything God may be **glorified** through Jesus Christ. To him belong glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen." (1 Peter 4:9-11)
