

## Exodus 23:10-17 The Eighth Day Sabbath

- I. Sacrificial Premeasurements of the Eighth Day Sabbath
  - A. Sacrificial maturity occurred on eighth day - Ex. 22:30, 22:27
  - B. Priestly work preceded by 7 days of consecration - Lev. 9:1
  - C. The purification of the temple culminated in an eighth day of the completion of the process, making it fit for the habitation of Jehovah –  
2 Chr. 29:17
  - D. The purification of the new covenant altar culminated in an **eighth day** acceptable sacrifice - Ezek. 43:27
  
- II. Old Covenant Death to Life Ceremonies Look to an 8th Day
  - A. The new creation of circumcision performed on the eighth day  
Gen. 17  

**Galatians 6:15 (NKJV) — 15** For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but a new creation.  
**2 Corinthians 5:17–18 (NKJV) — 17** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. **18** Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,
  - B. The purification of "deadness" culminated in an eighth day of re-entrance into fellowship w/Jehovah and His people - Lev. 14:10, 15:14,29, Numbers 6:10
  
- III. Old Testament "Required" Sabbaths, or days of rest convocation, looked forward to an 8th day Sabbath
  - A. Unleavened bread - Passover, The Sheaf Waved, day after the Sabbath - Lev. 23:11
  - B. Pentecost - After 7 sabbaths, Feast of Harvest Lev. 23:16, Acts 2
  - C. Tabernacles or Ingathering - Lev. 23:35, 39
  - D. Jubilee Lev. 25:8
  
- IV. Jesus' Resurrection and Appearances on the 8th Day
