Exodus 20:15: "You shall not steal."

LAOdus 20.13. Tou shall not steat.
II. What the 8th Commandment Requires
-Good stewardship (Gen. 1:28; Ps. 8:6)
As good stewards:
1) We will work hard (Prov. 10:4; 30:8, 9; Matt. 25:26; Eph. 4:28).
2) We will take good care of what God gives us (Gen. 2:15).
3) We will respect the persons and property of others (Matt. 7:12; Rom. 13:9; 1 Tim. 5:8).
4) We will trust God (Phil. 4:6).
5) We will be content with what God gives us (Josh. 6, 7; 1 Tim. 6:8-10; Heb. 13:5).
Practical Lessons
1) Jesus is the Savior from sin, not a biblical worldview.
2) Are the marks of good stewardship present in your life, by the grace of God?

3) Jesus is as merciful and forgiving a Savior, as He is generous.
