## God is with us to sovereignly \_\_\_\_\_ during trials (1-6)

- Meanwhile Joseph was taken to Egypt (1)
- Where the LORD was with Him to bless him (2-6)
  - Joseph's blessing from the LORD was \_\_\_\_\_ by Potiphar (3)
  - Joseph was given two prominent roles by Potiphar (4)
    - \_\_\_\_\_ servant
    - Estate \_\_\_\_\_
  - Joseph's blessing resulted in blessing for Potiphar's house (5)
  - Therefore Potiphar had \_\_\_\_\_ in Joseph to whom he gave charge of nearly everything (6a)

## Knowing God is with us during trials prepares us to \_\_\_\_\_ during trials (6b-18)

- Temptations come when God is with us during trials in the context of \_\_\_\_\_ (6b)
- \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ temptations can come even when God is with us during trials (7)
- Temptations can be resisted when we honestly consider the results of giving in to temptation (8-9)
  - Giving in to temptation would result in sinning \_\_\_\_\_ by betraying their trust (8-9a)
  - Giving in to temptation would result in sinning against \_\_\_\_\_ (9b)

- Even \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ temptations can be experienced and yet still resisted during a trial when God is with us (10)
- Resisting temptation always involves on some level an element of \_\_\_\_\_ (11-12)
- Obediently resisting temptation may result in being \_\_\_\_\_ (13-18)

## God is with us to sovereignly bless us when our obedience during a trials leads to \_\_\_\_\_ (19-23)

- Obediently resisting temptation may result in a \_\_\_\_\_ trial rather than immediate perceivable \_\_\_\_\_ (19-21)
- But because God is with His children to bless them He does \_\_\_\_\_ obedience according to His secret sovereign \_\_\_\_\_ (22-23)
