**TITLE: "God is All-Knowing!" (Series: Attributes of God)**

→ God is Holy, Eternal, Present Everywhere (Omnipresent), Faithful, Gracious, Immutable, Love, Sovereign, All-Powerful (Omnipotent), and ALL-KNOWING (Omniscient).

\* "Omni" is the Latin prefix that means "all". So, we have Omni-present, Omni-potent, Omni-scient, and have you heard of Omnificent, which means "creating all things"?
