"That You May Live" Deuteronomy 4: 1 - 14 May 16, 2010

- God Has Told Us What Is Necessary To Live In Abundance, (vs. 1 14)
 - God Says, Listening To My Word Is Commanded, Not Suggested, (vs. 1)
 - God's nature is to tell us plainly what He expects, (vs. 1a)
 - ¥ "You shall not do as they DO in the land of Egypt, where you LIVED,
 - ✓ and you shall not DO as they do in the land of Canaan, to which I am bringing you.
 - ✓ You shall not WALK in their statutes. You shall FOLLOW my rules and KEEP my statutes and walk in them.
 - ✓ I am the Lord your God." (Leviticus 18:3-4)
 - **4** "And I will put my Spirit within you, and CAUSE you to WALK in my statutes and be CAREFUL to OBEY my rules." (Ezekiel 36:27)
 - God's expectation is that we will do what He says, (vs. 1b)
 - "The whole commandment that I command you today you shall BE careful to do,
 - that you may LIVE and MULTIPLY, and GO in and POSSESS the land that the Lord SWORE to give to your fathers.
 - And you shall remember the whole way that the Lord your God HAS LED you these forty years in the wilderness,
 - > that he might humble you, testing you to know what was in your heart, whether you would KEEP his commandments or not.
 - And he HUMBLED you and LET you hunger and FED you with manna, which you did not KNOW, nor DID your fathers know,
 - ✓ that he might make you know that man does not LIVE by bread alone, but man LIVES by every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord.
 - Your clothing did not WEAR out on you and your foot did not SWELL these forty years.
 - * Know then in your heart that, as a man DISCIPLINES his son, the Lord your God disciplines you." (Deuteronomy 8:1-5)
 - God's promise is that abundance will follow obedience, (vs. 1c)
 - Working together with him, then, we appeal to you not to receive the grace of God in vain.
 - For he says, "In a favorable time I listened to you, and in a day of salvation I have helped you."
 - BEHOLD, now is the favorable time; BEHOLD, now is the day of salvation. We put no obstacle in anyone's way, so that no fault may be found with our ministry,
 - but as servants of God we commend ourselves in every way: by great endurance, in afflictions, hardships, calamities, beatings, imprisonments, riots, labors, sleepless nights, hunger;
 - by purity, knowledge, patience, kindness, the Holy Spirit, genuine love; by truthful speech, and the power of God;
 - with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and for the left; through honor and dishonor, through slander and praise.
 - We are treated as impostors, and yet are true; as unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and BEHOLD, we live; as punished, and yet not killed; as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, yet possessing everything." (2 Corinthians 6:1-10)
