• **God Has Told Us What Is Necessary To Live In Abundance, (vs. 1 - 14)**

Listening To My Word Is Commanded, Not Suggested Amending My Word Is Not Allowed Following My Word Is Something I Take VERY Seriously Acknowledging My Word As The Sovereign Making My Word A Priority Will Be Noticed By Others

- God Says, Accepting My Word Puts You In A Very Special Place, (vs. 7 - 8)
 - There is none other who is as immanent as God when we hearken to His word, (vs. 7)
 - There is none other who redeems as God when we are changed by His word, (vs. 8)
- God Says, Hiding My Word In Your Heart Doesn't Mean Hiding It From Your Children, (vs. 9)
- God Says, Fearing My Word Is The Basis Of Lasting Wisdom, (vs. 10)
- God Says, Remembering My Word Comes With Real Power Can't Be Overlooked, (vs. 11)
- God Says, Believing My Word Is Dependent On Who I Am & Not What You Experience, (vs. 12)
- God Says, Communicating My Word Is Straight Forward & Understandable, (vs. 13)
- God Says, Following My Word Has To Be Part Of Who You Are, (vs. 14)
