Leader: Which is the fifth commandment?

People: The fifth commandment is, Honor thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

Leader: What is required in the fifth commandment?

People: The fifth commandment requires the preserving the honor, and performing the duties, belonging to everyone in their several places and relations, as superiors, inferiors, or equals.

Leader: What is forbidden in the fifth commandment?

People: The fifth commandment forbids the neglecting of, or doing anything against, the honor and duty which belongs to everyone in their several places and relations. (Shorter Catechism 63-65)

People: We confess we have been disobedient to our parents and those others you have put in authority over us.

All: We earnestly beg your forgiveness, Father, and that you would forgive these and all our sins.
