1. Maritally she is to love her husband

a. By having a good reputation

Do not give your strength to women, Or your ways to that which destroys kings. Proverbs 31:3

Likewise, I want women to adorn themselves with proper clothing, modestly and discreetly, not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly garments, but rather by means of good works, as is proper for women making a claim to godliness. 1 Timothy 2:9-10

Women must likewise be dignified, not malicious gossips, but temperate, faithful in all things. 1 Timothy 3:11

b. Self-controlled

2. Maternally she is to love her children

But women will be preserved through the bearing of children if they continue in faith and love and sanctity with self-restraint. 1 Timothy 2:15

3. Mentally she is to be sensible

One of themselves, a prophet of their own, said, Cretans are always liars, evil beasts, lazy gluttons. This testimony is true. For this reason reprove them severely so that they may be sound in the faith, not paying attention to

*Older men are to be temperate, dignified, sensible, sound in faith, in love, in

*instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly,
righteously and godly in the present age, Titus 2:12*

4. Morally she is to be pure

a. Seek _____

*Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet
what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him,
because we will see Him just as He is. And everyone who has this
hope fixed on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure. 1 John 3:2-3*

b. Purity Starts _____

*You have heard that it was said, You shall not commit adultery; but I
say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lust for her has
already committed adultery with her in his heart. Matthew 5:27-28*

c. By Staying _____

*Now flee from youthful lusts and pursue righteousness, faith, love and
peace, with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart. 2 Timothy
2:22*

*Flee immorality. Every other sin that a man commits is outside the
body, but the immoral man sins against his own body. 1 Corinthians
6:18*

d. How to defend against impurity:

- prepare for situations
- plan your environment
- pick your people

Do not be deceived: Bad company corrupts good morals. 1

Corinthians 15:33

- ponder your appearance
- pounce on your thought
