- 1. Pharaoh was held responsible for what his people would suffer (1-2)
- a. He strengthened his grip against them (2)
- 1) He is holding on to God's property (Acts 20:28; Gal. 1:13)
- 2) A battle of wills was occurring
 - a) God's redemption vs. Satan's enslavement
- 2. The plague was extensive & very personal (9:3)
- B THE DESTRUCTION WAS COMING QUICKLY (5)
- 1. God set the date
- C. THE DESTRUCTION CAME UPON THE EGYPTIANS ONLY (6)
- D. PHARAOH DID NOT LEARN FROM THIS JUDGMENT (7)

- A. PAINFUL BOILS
- 1. The instruction to Moses (8)
- 2. The prediction (9)
