Lesson 5: The Work of God or Satan?

Matthew 12.15-37

I. <u>THE MESSIANIC SECRET(16-21; Isa 42:1-4)</u> Their expectations were off.

A. The Messiah's Identity (18a)

- 1. God's <u>Servant</u>- prestigious title; authority to rule or act & speak on God's behalf
- **2.** God's <u>Chosen</u>—not elected or randomly appointed; not a human decision
- **3.** God's <u>Beloved</u> (Mat 3:17)—unique, personal relationship of affection and favor
- 4. God's <u>Pleasure</u> (Mat 3:17)—we find God's pleasure/favor in Him

B. <u>The Messiah's Mission:</u> To Establish <u>Justice</u> (18b, 20b-21)

- 1. A Message of <u>Hope</u>—(21; Isa 8:14; Rom 9:33; 1 Pet 2:6)—Jesus Christ, the longawaited Messiah of God, is the <u>only hope</u> for the human race.
- 2. A Message for <u>All Nations</u> (Mat 8:11)—Israel's King is the Savior of the World.

C. The Messiah's Manner (19-20)

- **1.** <u>**Gentle**</u>—not attempting to establish His agenda by force
- 2. <u>Patient</u>—growth process
 - a. Spreading the Gospel (Mat 24:14) evangelism
 - b. Sanctifying our Lives (Phil 1:6) growth in grace
- **3.** <u>Faithful</u> (Isa 42:4; Ph 1:6)—He won't give up until it is accomplished.
- **D.** <u>The Messiah's Means</u> (2 Cor 10:4). *The work of God must be in done God's way— spiritual transformation of the human soul.*
 - 1. <u>The Holy Spirit</u> (Zech 4:6)—supernatural source of power
 - **2.** <u>**Preaching**</u> (Rom 1:15-16; 1 Cor 1:21)—the "foolishness" of the gospel, God's power for salvation

II. THE KINGDOM COMES (22-30)

- A. Driving out the Devil (1 Jn 3:8; Rev 20:10)—to take back dominion usurped by Satan
 - 1. Evil Spirits are real and active in the world. Their goal is opposite to God's.
 - 2. The Kingdom of God is <u>routing</u> the forces of Satan. The Church advances in Christ's name.
- **B.** <u>A House Divided</u> (25)—the utter perverseness of the Pharisees' accusation
- C. Christ's Power (29)
 - 1. Binding the Strong Man—Jesus has bound and disabled Satan.
 - 2. Plundering His House—The Gates of Hell will not stand against the Church.
- **D.** <u>Competing Loyalties (30)</u>—no neutral ground; you work with Christ or against Him.

III. THE UNFORGIVEABLE SIN (31-37)

- A. <u>Blasphemy of the Holy Spirit Defined</u>:
 - **1.** <u>Slandering the Holy Spirit</u>—speaking against His person and work
 - 2. <u>Calling Good Evil and Evil Good</u> (Isa 5:20)—*radically, diabolically reinterpreting* moral reality in a way that is diametrically opposed to the truth
 - 3. <u>Hardened Rejection</u>—deliberate, willful and decisive; not ignorance or accident
- B. <u>A Revelation of the Heart</u> (33-37)—Your words betray you. (a tree and its fruit)
- **C.** <u>By Definition Unforgiveable</u>—One has steadfastly rejected the power that would make repentance and forgiveness possible.
 - 1. Sin must be <u>repented</u> to be forgiven. (11:23; 2 Thes 2:10-12)
 - 2. God does not refuse to forgive: we refuse to repent. (1 Jn 1:8-10)
- D. Everything Else Forgivable (31a; 11:23) ALL other sins—no sin is too great!
