#### Signs of the Times

Matthew (23:33-) 24:1-35

# I. APPRECIATING THE ARCHITECTURE (Jer 7:1-15)

- A. <u>Beautiful Buildings</u> (Mk 13:1)—Look what we built for God!
- B. Impressive Forms—We know the correct way to order worship/church government!
- **C.** <u>Empty Religion</u> (1 Sam 4:21; Mat 21:13 & 23:38; Jn 4:20-23)—*abandon true relationship God but cling to the form of their religion: lip service and good luck charms.*
- **D.** <u>Impending Destruction</u> (24:2)—not one stone left upon another
  - 1. Fulfilled in AD 70—Jerusalem conquered and Temple destroyed
  - **2.** Application for Us—What *we* have built must not compete with what *He is building*. He will tear it down.

### II. ANTICIPATING THE END (3)

- A. <u>Reading the Signs</u>—Already fulfilled; Yet to be fulfilled; Continuing to be fulfilled?
  - 1. False Christs and False Prophets—leading many astray, even miraculous signs
  - 2. International Political Unrest—wars & rumors of wars
  - **3.** Natural Disasters—famines, earthquakes
  - 4. Great Tribulation—hated, persecuted, martyrdom for faith in Jesus
  - 5. Pervasive Wickedness (Lawlessness)—will increase
  - 6. Great Apostasy—love will grow cold, many will fall away
  - 7. Gospel Preached to All Nations—the only sign that has not already taken place!
- B. <u>Heeding the Signs</u>—Why does Jesus tell us these things?

- **1. Don't Be** <u>**Deceived**</u>. (4, 24-25)—Jesus is the Christ; don't look for/follow *anyone else*.
- 2. Don't Be <u>Alarmed</u>. (6)—It's part of the plan; it will get *worse before it gets better*.
  → Childbirth, not cancer—there *will be pain*, but the end is *good*!
- **3.** Prepare to <u>Endure</u>. (13) It is only for a limited time. Your faith is not in vain.

# III. WAITING FOR JESUS (30-31)—He will return.

## A. It Will Be Obvious.

- 1. Like Lightening (27)—dramatic and unambiguous
- 2. Astronomical Shaking (29-30)—solar and lunar eclipse and meteor/asteroid storm
- **3.** On the Clouds (30; Dan 7:13-14)—Daniel's prophecy, divine Son of Man receiving everlasting dominion of all nations
- 4. With His Angels (30)—indicates His deity; He commands the Hosts of Heaven
- 5. With a Loud Trumpet (31; 1 Thes 4:16)—not something quiet that you might miss!
- B. The Tribes of the Earth Will Mourn. (Ps 2)
  - 1. Repentance? (Zech 12:10-12)—seems to indicate the repentance of Israel as a nation
  - 2. Despair? (Rev 6:16; Lk 23:30)—clearly pictures the terror and despair enemies of God
- C. <u>The Elect Will Be Saved</u>. (31) He will preserve the elect; He knows where you are and His angels will gather you!
- D. <u>The Promise Is Sure</u>. (35; Rom 8:35-39; Psalm 46; Deut 33:27) He will return for us and nothing—not life or death or anything that will take place—has the power to separate us from Jesus.
