The Woman at the Well

(John 4:1-42)

- I. <u>DIVINE APPOINTMENT</u> (4-6; Mat 9:12-13; Lk 19:10)—Jesus intentionally seeks out the despised and rejected.
 - A. Jesus' Itinerary (4)—not just through Samaria but to this woman and this town
 - **B.** <u>Jesus' Timing</u> (6)—to intercept a reclusive soul in its loneliness and shame
 - Jesus seeks us out in our places of shame and insecurity.
 - C. <u>Jesus' Method</u> (6)—How He brought the gospel
 - **1.** A Shared Humanity—He is *tired*.
 - Our shared humanity creates empathy and opportunity to reach out to others.
 - 2. A Profound Humility (Phil 2:5-8)—He asks (a woman!) for help.
 - Our needs connect us to other people.

II. PAINFUL WOUNDS

- A. <u>Hated for Race</u>—She is a *Samaritan*, a race particularly despised by Jews.
 - → Jesus *drinks* after a Samaritan!
- B. <u>Dismissed for Gender</u>—She is a *woman*, not considered the equal of a man.
 - → Jesus *talks* with a woman—as if she is worthy of His time and conversation and has a mind capable of understanding!

- **C. Ashamed of Sin**—**She is living an immoral life**, despised by respectable society.
 - → Jesus is a **friend** of sinners!
- **III. EVASIVE MEASURES**...Trying to Hold Jesus at Bay
 - A. Spiritual Dullness (15)—we want a guick, superficial fix to the pain of life.
 - → Jesus wants to cure the cause of our distress, not just manage the symptoms!
 - B. <u>Doctrinal Distraction</u> (19, 20)—defense mechanism to avoid revealing her heart
 - → Jesus always goes for the heart!
 - C. Futuristic Abstraction (25)—someday we will get around to figuring it out
 - → Jesus offers us Himself, here and now.
- **IV.** The Woman's Testimony (28-30; Ps 34:1-8; 1 Cor 1:26-31)—woman evangelist
 - A. Not Ashamed of Her Sin Anymore (Ps 78;)—now only a backdrop for grace
 - **B.** <u>Jesus Is the Focus and the Hero</u> (Rom 1:16-17)—not how good (or bad) I am but how worthy Jesus is
 - C. <u>Bringing Others to Jesus</u> (39-42; Jn 1:14; Ps 34:4-11; Jer 12:19-21)
 - → Witnessing is one poor beggar telling another beggar where to find bread!
