The flood is a prototype of God's final judgment and salvation.

Is our culture ripe for judgment?

Are there any Noah's in the crowd today?

The flood is also a story of salvation. (1 Peter 3:18-21)

Noah's Transformed Character

How is Noah a contrast? What does his name mean? (Gen 5:29)

God's Favor

Noah found it, in Genesis 6:8.

Which came first, the chicken or the egg?

Where does faith come from? (Ephesians 2:8-9)

Noah was righteous - blameless - walked with God.

Noah's Strange Commission

This is a big ask.

Are we ashamed to suffer ridicule for the cause of Christ?

"Noah did this; he did all that God commanded him."

I have established/ confirmed my covenant with you. v 18

What is this covenant of grace?

God is preserving the seed of the woman; God is keeping his promise.

The Covenant is what God promises to do, we embrace his gift by faith.

Noah's Obedient Conduct

He did every thing that God told him to do. V 22

Holiness is counter cultural.

The flood shows that God's mercy has limits. (2 Peter 3:4-7)

The candle is still burning.

Many people tremble at the warnings of Scripture, and they should. But hear the grace of God for the people of God. (Isaiah 54:9-10)
