Jhn 5:19 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.

#### They were LUKEWARM

Jos 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.

#### The Lord's Rebuke "Iknow thy works"

- The Lord was less concerned about their preaching, their singing, and their outward appearance and more about their WORKS
- Their works were the manifestation of their true
  SPIRITUAL nature

The Lord's Rebuke "I know thy works"

"Their being lukewarm spiritually was evidenced by their being content with their material wealth and their being unaware of their spiritual poverty" ~~ J. Walvoord

The Lord's Rebuke "Iknow thy works"

#### Material wealth has a way of replacing our DEVOTION to God

Mat 19:24 And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.

Lukewarmness is utterly DETESTABLE to God

The Lord's Exhortation

- 1. To be ZEALOUS and repent
  - 2. To get true riches

Mat 6:19-20 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: <sup>20</sup> But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal

The Lord's Exhortation

- 3. To correct their spiritual blindness
  - ► fixing their EYES upon Jesus
- 4. To clothe themselves in white
  - pursuit of righteousness rather than WORLDLINESS
