James 4:10

But it shall not be so among you: but whosoever will be great among you, let him be your minister; And whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant:

Matthew 20:26-27

Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:

1 Peter 5:6

The One Who is LIFE...came to DIE, in order that we who were dead... ...might have life!

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the LIFE: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

John 14:6

Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

John 12:24

The One Who was **RICH** beyond description became **POOR**...that we who had nothing might enjoy of the riches of Heaven!

For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

FINDING (gaining) life, happiness, success, etc... ...comes through LOSING!

He that findeth his life shall lose it; and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.

Matthew 10:39

But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for Christ. Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ.

It is the **FOOLISH**whom God chooses and uses to confound the **WISE**!

But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: that no flesh should glory in his presence.

1 Corinthians 1:27-29

It is in **GIVING**... ...that we **RECEIVE!**

I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive.

Acts 20:35

Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.

Luke 6:38

Genuine STRENGTH... ...comes through WEAKNESS!

And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee; for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.

The LAST shall be FIRST... and the first last!

So the last shall be first, and the first last: for many be called, but few chosen.

Matthew 20:16

Self-righteousness is NO righteousness...and no self-righteousness allows for DECLARED righteousness!

And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of faith.

Philippians 3:9

We find **REST**... under His **YOKE**!

Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my voke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.
