Lesson 13: Treasure and Worry

Matthew 6:19-34; Philippians 4:4-13

I. <u>SEARCHING FOR TREASURE</u> (19-23)

- A. What Are You Looking For?
 - 1. What do you value? What are you willing to pay for, to sacrifice for?
 - 2. How will you get it? In what do you ultimately trust?
- **B.** How Is Your Vision? (22-23) Where are you looking and with what mindset?
 - **1. Choosing Your Focus -** A near sighted focus obscures things in the distance.
 - 2. Discerning True Value Does it bring you true joy and lasting pleasure?
- **C.** Where Is Your Heart?- It's with your treasure. What brings you the most joy or causes you the most concern?

II. CHOOSING YOUR MASTER (24)

Mammon refers to wealth and property—think money, houses, land, food, clothes, toys, etc...

- **A. Competing Claims -** both lay exclusive claim to your time and money and loyalty.
- **B. Rival Affections -** different values, clash of priorities; serving one means betraying the other
- **C.** A Matter of Worship You will serve the god you trust, the god whose values you share
- **III.** WHY WORRY? (25-32, 34)
 - **A.** The Reality of Our Vulnerability We are not in Eden anymore; the earth is not friendly.
 - 1. We are mortal. We are going to die.
 - **2. We are fragile.** It doesn't take much to *make* us die.
 - 3. We (think we) are alone. Estranged from God; who's going to take care of us?

B. The Wrongness of Worry

- 1. It is futile. (27) It doesn't help.
- 2. It is <u>sinful</u>. (30, 32a) Habitual worry is the practice of unbelief.
- 3. It is inefficient. (34) wasteful of time, energy, emotional resources; doesn't produce
- **4.** It is unnecessary. (32b) There is a God; He's got this!

C. The One You Can Trust (26-32)

1. The <u>Character</u> of God

- **a.** His Personal Knowledge He knows everything about you and your circumstances.
- **b.** His Attentive Care He is interested in you and He is completely invested in you.
- **c. His Generous Provision** He's *rich* and He is *extravagant* in His generosity!

2. Your Heavenly Father (26, 32)

- a. He claims you as His child. He takes responsibility for you as your Father!
- **b. You are precious to Him.** You are *His treasure*!

IV. <u>SEEKING FIRST THINGS FIRST</u> (33)

A. The Object of our Seeking (Rom 14:17)

- 1. God's Kingdom ("Thy kingdom come")—honor and serve Him as king
- **2. His Righteousness** ("Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven")—that everything be done righteously on earth as it is in heaven
- **B.** The <u>Priority</u> of our Seeking *first/top priority* of your life; sacrifice other things, not *this!*
- **C.** The <u>Effort</u> of Seeking (6:9-10) absorbed in the search; persevering and strenuous effort
- **D.** The <u>Provision</u> of Everything Else (6:11; Phil 4:19)
 - 1. You can't be devoted to God if you are worrying about other things.
 - 2. You won't serve a God you don't trust.
 - 3. God is able to meet all your needs.
