## The Daughter of Jairus

(Mk 5:22, 23, 35-42; Jn 1:1-18)

## I. THE FAITH OF A FATHER

- **A.** <u>Seeking Jesus</u>—the One in whom faith is placed
- **B.** <u>Falling at Jesus' Feet</u>—posture of humble desperation
- C. Interceding for His Daughter—not her faith for herself; her father's
  - 1. The intercession of <u>parents</u> for children
  - 2. The intercession of <u>friend</u> for friend (Mk 2:3-5)
  - The intercession of the <u>church</u> for its members (Act 12:5; Js 5:14-15)

## II. THE VOICES OF UNBELIEF (35-40)

- **A.** <u>Whispering</u> (35; Ps 112:6-8)—*The fear of bad news* 
  - **1.** You're <u>too late</u>. The worst thing you feared has happened.
  - 2. You're bothering God. Insecurity and Pride
  - 3. This is too hard, even for Jesus. Death is final.
- B. Clamoring (38-39; Mat 9:23)—Weeping, Wailing, and Sad Music
  - 1. Sometimes you need to shut out others and be alone with Jesus.
  - 2. Sometimes you need to change the music.
- C. <u>Scoffing</u> (40; Ps 1:1; Jude 18)—*Ridiculing of Faith*

- **III. THE PERSPECTIVE OF JESUS** (41-42) "She is not dead but sleeping."
  - A. The Metaphor of Sleeping (Jn 11:11-14)—euphemism or teaching?

## B. The Authority of Jesus

- 1. <u>His Word (Gen 1, Jn 1; Heb 1:3; Jn 5:28-29</u>)
  - a. The authoritative command of God at Creation
  - b. The authoritative explanation of God at the Incarnation
  - c. The authoritative command of Christ at the Resurrection
- 2. <u>His Touch</u> (23; Num 19:11)
  - a. <u>Conveys Authority</u>—OT Patriarchs and NT Apostles
  - **b.** <u>Transmits Grace</u>—spiritual blessing or miracle
  - **c.** <u>**Ritual Impurity**</u>—touching a corpse would make you unclean but the greater power wins!
- C. <u>The Antidote to Fear</u> (Lk 12:32)—Jesus
  - 1. Jesus Cares. He is the Incarnation of God's compassion!
  - 2. Jesus Responds to Intercession. (Eph 5:1-9) Parents, friends, church
  - *3.* Jesus Can Handle Anything. (Prov 14:32; Mat 28:20; Rom 8:35-39; Heb 13:5; Ps 16) *Even death; certainly life!*
