## **The Widow at Her Son's Funeral**

(Isa 61:1-3; Lk 7:11-15)

- **I.** THE WOMAN'S DESOLATION (12)—a widow, her only son
  - A. Grief—deep emotional anguish; intense sorrow, distress or suffering,
  - **B.** Fear—vulnerability of women, old age
    - **1.** Provision in Old Age—uncertain of the future
    - 2. <u>Protection as a Woman</u>—physical, legal, practical
    - **3.** <u>Identity</u>—relational; who am I now?
  - **C.** Loneliness—loss of relationship
- II. <u>CHRIST'S COMPASSION</u> (13-15)
  - **A.** Empathy (13; Isa 53:3, 63:9; Lk 2:35; Jn 19:26) *His heart went out to her;* God's heart hurts when His children hurt.
    - 1. Our experience of pain equips us to comfort others. (2 Cor 1:3-4)
    - 2. <u>Jesus has experienced sorrow, so He can empathize with ours!</u> (Heb 10:17-18)
  - **B.** Comfort (13; Lk 4:17-21)—he wants to dry our tears
    - 1. Jesus understands tears! (Heb 5:7)
    - 2. <u>Jesus bears our sorrows</u>. (Isa 53:3-4)
    - 3. Jesus heals our hearts. (Isa 61:1-3)

- C. <u>Touch</u> (14; Lev 21:1, 10-11; Num 19:11; Lk 10:30-35)—*Incarnation overpowers ceremonial cleanliness* 
  - **1.** <u>Human misery</u> matters more to Jesus than <u>His status</u>. (Lk 10:30-35; Heb 2:11)
  - 2. He <u>came to take</u> our sin and its punishment <u>upon Himself</u>. (2 Cor 5:21; Heb 2:9)—the Great Exchange

## III. A GREAT PROPHET (16)

- **A.** <u>Compassionate Care for Widows</u> (Ps 68:5; 1 Kin 17:7-24/ Lk 4:26; 2 Kin 4:1-7)
- B. Miraculous Power to Raise the Dead (2 Kin 4:8-37; 13:21)
  - 1. Validation of Jesus' Ministry (Jn 3:2; 14:11; Act 2:22; 14:3)
  - **2.** Clue to His <u>Identity</u> (Deut 18:15, 18-19; )—*THE Prophet; listen to Him*!
- C. God's Presence with His People (16-17; Ps 23:4)—
  - 1. Inspires <u>Awe</u>—God is here, doing supernatural things
  - 2. Produces Praise—they glorified God
  - **3. Provides** Help—we are not alone
