Title: **Walking With God** - Lesson 9

Text: **Micah 6:8**

Subject: Walking humbly with Him

Anyone who truly knows God and walks with Him is humbled by the experience. When confronted by the presence of God...

- Peter said, *"Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord."* (Luke 5:8)
- Manoah said, *"We shall surely die, because we have seen God."* (Jud. 13:22)
- Job said, *"...I abhor myself. And repent in dust and ashes."* (Job 42:6)
- Isaiah said, *"Woe is me! For I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips..."* (Isaiah 6:5)
- A centurion said, *"Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldst come under my roof..."* (Matthew 8:8)
- Judas Iscariot said, *"I have betrayed the innocent blood..."* (Matthew 27:4)
- Another centurion said, *"Truly this was the Son of God."* (Matthew 27:54)
- Micah said, *"Who is a God like unto thee..."* (Micah 7:18)
- Thomas said, *"My Lord and my God."* (John 20:28)
- A Greek lady said, *"...yet the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their master's table."* (Matthew 15:27)
- A demon said, *"I know thee who thou art, the Holy One of God."* (Mark 1:24)
- John said, *"And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead."* (Rev. 1:17)
- David said, *"Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me."* (Psalm 51:5)
- Moses said, *"who am I..."* (Exodus 3:11)
- Everyone will someday say, *"Jesus Christ is Lord..."* (Phil. 2:11)

Why not now? Let us walk humbly with God. Pride is the great enemy of humility. God does not walk with proud people (Psalm 138:6).

God hates pride. Beyond hatred it is an abomination to Him (Prov. 6:16-19;8:13) God resists (fights against) the proud (James 4:6). Pride precedes destruction (Proverbs 16:18). Pride is the constant state of thinking about oneself. It is an overinflated opinion about oneself. Pride was the original sin of Satan because of his beauty (Ezekiel 28:17). Pride fathers rebellion against God ordained authority and fosters a stubborn heart (1 Samuel 15:22-23).

God is better than us! He is omniscient, omnipresent, omnipotent, and immutable. We are nothing (Galatians 6:3). It should take no effort to walk humbly with Him! Let us follow the advice of Job (Job 40:3-5) and enjoy the benefits of the disciples on the Road to Emmaus. (Luke 24:32)
