Lesson 19: The Gadarene Demoniac (People, Pigs & Profit)

Matthew 8:28-34 (Mark 5:1-20; Luke 8:26-39); Isaiah 61:1-3

I. REGARDING DEMON POSESSION (Two errors: deny/ignore existence or obsess on it)

A. Satan Is Real.

- 1. His forces are active. Battle for human souls and for rulership of this planet
- 2. His agents are personal. Spoke/answered, had a name

B. Satan Opposes Everything That Is of God.

- 1. Satan hates humans.
 - **a.** He hates the image of God. Humans bear God's image.
 - b. He knows his <u>authority was usurped</u> from Adam. He wants no competition
- **2. Satan opposes** <u>life</u>. (Jn 1:4 & 10:10 & 14:6; 1 Jn 5:12)
 - **a.** He wills death. Man lived among the tombs; demons drove pigs to drown
 - b. He enjoys anything that inhibits life. Can't create; can only pervert & destroy
- 3. Satan despises <u>freedom</u>. (Isa 42:7 & 61:1; 2 Cor 3:17)
 - a. Satan wants to control people; God wants to teach self-control.
 - b. Satan wants to erase personalities; God delights in individuals.
- 4. Satan works against peace.
 - **a. He wills insanity.** (2 Tim 2:20) *Holy Spirit produces clarity and a sound mind.*
 - **b.** He wills violence. (Gal 5:23) Holy Spirit produces gentleness.
 - **c. He wills torment.** (Gal 5:22; Rom 8:6) *external and internal; Holy Spirit brings* peace

C. Satan's power is real.

- **1.** It extracts a <u>terrible price</u>. Jesus' power is a <u>aift</u>—the Holy Spirit.
- 2. It is limited: by the authority of Jesus and the constraints of time. (29)

- **II. RECOGNIZING THE SON OF GOD** (Mat 4:3, 6; 1 Jn 3:8)
 - A. Remembering Christ's Temptation (Mat 4:3,6) "If you are the Son of God..."
 - B. Understanding Christ's Sonship—Israel's Divine Messiah King
 - 1. Israel's King (2 Sam 7:12-16; Ps 2:7)—the one who ruled Israel as God's anointed
 - 2. <u>Israel's Representative</u> (Ex 4:22; Hos 11:1-2; Mat 2:15)—reenacts Israel's history to pass the test of faithfulness that the nation failed
 - 3. Jesus' Divinity (3:17; Jn 5:15-18)—His unique relationship with God the Father
 - C. Fearing Christ's Authority (Phil 2:9-11; Mat 16:18)
 - 1. Exorcism is a sign of God's Kingdom coming.
 - a. Individual Human Souls
 - b. Demonic Strongholds (thought, imagination, institutions, culture)
 - c. The Nations
 - 2. The Authority of Christ brings **Shalom**.
- III. REJECTING THE DELIVERER (Acts 16:16-24; 1 Jn 3:8)
 - A. Heaven's Values—at odds with the goals and values of this world

If you have bought into the World, you will be threatened by Jesus.

B. <u>Divine Disruption</u>—Jesus will disrupt the status quo.

If you have placed your confidence in Satan's strongholds, you will be threatened by Jesus.

C. The Coming Kingdom—Jesus will return judge and to completely vanquish Satan.

Exorcism is a sign of Christ's authority and the reality of His Kingdom, which is advancing now and will be consummated when He returns.
