Passover and God's Redemption Exodus 12:1-36 April 5, 2020

God's covenant feasts speak truth to the people of God.

I will look at the feast of Passover and expound it by the gospel.

I would like to communicate this truth in an unusual way. Not with a Greek or Western mindset - a 3 point monologue sermon, but rather in a Hebraic, or eastern mindset, with a relational dialogue.

Therefore let us listen to a father explaining Passover to his son.

Father, why do we put blood on our door?

Today is passover, son.

Did Pharaoh let the people go?

Were you there, father?

Father, what was it like, that first Passover?

Would any lamb do?

Why must we eat unleavened bread?

Why must we eat the lamb?

Why must we wear traveling clothes?

Why did God do all those great things in Egypt?

So, what does God tell us in the Passover meal?

So what does Passover mean for Christians, like us?

The Lord's Supper was started during a Passover meal. Did Jesus do that on purpose?

Remembering is one of the chief ingredients of faith.
