Resurrection: the Conspiracy & the Commission

Matthew 28:1-20; 1 Corinthians 15:12-27-32

- **THE EVENT** (1-10; 1 Cor 15:17-)—Something happened in human history that changed everything
 - A. The First Day—the Christian day of worship
 - B. The Awesome Signs—reported by the soldiers; foreshadowing the Final Resurrection
 - **1. The Earthquake** (Rev 6:12-17)—at Judgment, all tombs will be opened, all dead raised; the wicked will beg mountains and rocks to fall on them and hide them
 - **2. The Angel** (Mat 13:40-42, 49-50; 24:31)—the angels will separate the righteous from the wicked, escort souls to their final destiny; terror to wicked but comfort to saints
 - C. The Women's Honor—Last at the cross, first at the tomb
 - 1. Witnesses—not considered credible in Jewish courts of the day but equal in church
 - 2. Evangelists—commissioned by the angel and Jesus to take the good news to the men

II. THE MEANING —

- **A.** The Reality of the Supernatural (I Cor 15:12)—miracle; Naturalism & Deism can't explain
- **B.** The Vindication of Jesus Christ (Acts 17:31; Rom 1:4)
 - 1. He is the <u>Son of God</u>. (27:40-42; Acts 13:33-37)
 - **2.** He is <u>Beloved</u> of the Father. (3:17; 4:3,6; 27:43)—God does delight in Him!
- C. <u>The Acceptance of His Atonement</u> (Acts 13:32-33; 1 Pet 1:3, 21& 3:18)—*it worked;* we are forgiven—free from guilt
- D. <u>His Victory over Death</u> (Jn 11:25; Acts 2:24; Rom 6:9, 8:11 & 14:9;)—*He will raise our bodies to eternal life*—free from curse
- E. <u>The Truth of His Teaching</u> (Jn 12:49-50)—Everything He said is trustworthy and authoritative.

III. THE CONSPIRACY (11-15)—the chief priests and elders

- A. The Relentless Unbelief (Lk 16:31; 2 Thes 10-11)—preferred a lie
- B. The Expensive Bribe—paid to propagate their narrative
- C. The Official Story—what the newspaper will report

IV. THE COMMISSION (16-20)—

- A. The Authority: The Divine Son of Man (Dan 7:13-14)—"Jesus is Lord"
 - 1. They worshipped Him. (Jn 20:28)
 - 2. All Authority has been given to Him. (Phil 2:9-11)
 - **a.** In **Heaven**—in the realm of spirits
 - **b.** On Earth—in the realm of nature and mortals

B. The Command

- 1. Go to All Nations ()
 - **a. Action**—Evangelism (bigger than official program or formula)
 - **b. Non-discrimination**—Universal Invitation
- 2. Make Disciples
 - a. Baptize (Conversion, Public Profession, The Trinity)
 - **b. Teach** (Discipleship, OBEDIANCE—practical holiness)
- C. The Promise ()—The Presence of Jesus; we are NEVER ALONE!
- V. THE PERSPECTIVE (Rom 8:31-39)— No Fear!
 - **A.** For Death (Mat 10:28; Jn 5:21-29 & 11:25-26; Rom 8:11; 1 Cor 6:14; Rev 1:18)
 - **B.** For Life (Rom 8:31-39; Heb 13:6)
 - C. For Eternity (Mk 10:30; Jn 11:25; 2 Cor 4:16-18; Tit 3:7)—secure, eternal optimism
