

Waiting on God from the Pit, Again
Psalm 40
May 27, 2018

You have been in the pit before, and you will again.

What does David do while he is in the pit?

Remembering God's Past Deliverances (v 1-2)

What does waiting on God mean?

Does God hear? (Psalm 17:6; 31:2)

Praising God for Past Deliverances (v 3)

How does God place a song of praise in David's mouth?

How are others affected with David's praise?

Trust in God, Don't follow Man's easy solutions (v 4)

Focus on the Greatness of your God (v 5)

Don't fixate on your current situation; Think of the glory of your God.

Be willing and ready to serve God from the Heart (v 6-8)

The end game of God is not ritual observance but heartfelt obedience.

God has opened his ears. (3 possible interpretations)

What was David saying about himself in this passage?

Bear Witness to God's Goodness, from the Pit (v 9-10)

God's Past Faithfulness yields present confidence, from the Pit (v 11)

Fully embrace your current situation (v 12)

Pray for deliverance (v 13)

Have Confidence in God's future justice (v 14-15)

Corporate Praise (v 16)

Plea for deliverance (v 17)
